## – ARREST – ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON ON A PEACE OFFICER

**Santa Monica, CA** –The Santa Monica Police Department has dedicated many resources to identify and arrest those involved in the crimes committed in our community on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. The Santa Monica Police Department was able to identify Drew Miller as the one who threw a full 40-ounce glass bottle at the back of the head of a peace officer during the civil unrest and rioting in the City of Santa Monica on May 31, 2020. The large glass bottle shattered on the peace officer's helmet causing injury.

On Friday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the Santa Monica Police Department obtained an arrest warrant for Drew Miller and placed him under arrest for 245(c) of the California Penal Code – Assault with a deadly weapon upon a peace officer. Miller was transported to the Santa Monica Jail Facility and held on \$500,000 bail.
